Background

The technical training will examine the evolving global debt market with a comparative focus on African and international financial systems, highlighting recent developments in sovereign bond markets and their implications for emerging economies. It will explore the issuance of sovereign green bonds in local currency as a key tool for sustainable and climate-aligned financing, particularly in Africa. A central focus will be debt transparency, drawing on the Indian experience to demonstrate how stronger disclosure frameworks can enhance investor confidence and market credibility. It will also look at how global debt market pressures—rising rates, shifting creditors, and refinancing deadlines intersect with Africa's financing realities.
